Matthew 21:7-11

They brought the donkey and the colt and placed their cloaks on them for Jesus to sit on. A very large crowd spread their cloaks on the road, while others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road. The crowds that went ahead of him and those that followed shouted, 'Hosanna to the Son of David!' 'Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!' 'Hosanna in the highest heaven!' When Jesus entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred and asked, 'Who is this?' The crowds answered, 'This is Jesus, the prophet from Nazareth in Galilee.'

Palm Sunday celebrates Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem

Jesus was greeted by people waving palm branches.

Beginning of Holy Week or Passion Week, the remembrance of Jesus' last days.

Jesus entered the city knowing He would be tried and crucified

Palm branches were a symbol of victory and triumph

- In the original Greek, it is written as "ὡσαννά" (hōsanná) Hosheanna

- **“If they kept quiet, the stones along the road would burst into cheers!”
